



# What is the gospel of Jesus?

*For with God, nothing shall be impossible, Luke 1:37*

*Sharing hope, motivation, and comfort in the Gospel, navigating life's uncertainties —*

- *The Lord freely created and blessed each of us, and loves each of us (Gen 1:27, Jn 3:16)*
- *No matter the situation, there is hope: God's salvation is found in Jesus: "I am the way, the truth, and the life, no one comes to the Father except through me"<sup>1</sup>*
- *God's word teaches that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"<sup>2</sup>; regretfully this leads to death, "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord"<sup>3</sup>; This spiritual problem requires a Savior (or deliverer) to save, heal and deliver us*
- *Scripture<sup>4</sup> teaches that the remedy for transgression is a spiritual substitute (or a sacrifice of a lamb) to take away the guilt, consequences, and the long term effects of sin. In the old testament, the children of Israel would symbolically sacrifice a lamb from time to time to remedy(atone) the effects and the consequences of sin*
- *In Jesus, we have God's perfect Lamb that takes away our sins, the consequences, and God forgives, grants us the gift-blessings of eternal life and restored fellowship*
- *Christ died for our sins on the Cross, was buried & after 3 days God raised Jesus from the dead<sup>5</sup>, "For God so loved the world that he gave His one and only son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life"*
- *What do we need to be saved? Salvation is a free gift of God available to all (there is no cost or price) – we need to believe in Jesus, God's Son by faith; We are saved by "grace through faith"<sup>6</sup>*
- *God wants us to change our ways (repentance), confess our sins and turn to Jesus' sacrifice to be forgiven and to receive spiritual healing<sup>7</sup>. God wants us to believe and receive Jesus, and become a part of God's blessed kingdom*

*"Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me, all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever" Psalm 23 Welcome to the kingdom of God! 😊*
